Chorges







(Serre-Ponçon)

A fairly strenuous route requiring a basic level of fitness, but offering exceptional panoramic views of the Val d'Avance, Piolit and the Aiguilles de Chabrières.

After a few hundred metres of ascent and passing the hamlet of Naune Raze, you'll find yourself in the alpine zone.

Look up and you may catch a glimpse of buzzards, falcons and other birds of prey. You will cross streams created by melting snow (which can dry up depending on the season).

- 1) From the car park, continue along the road for 200m before turning left onto a stony path. Continue straight on to the hamlet of Naune Raze.
- 2) Follow the main track, before turning left at Les Gontards. Follow the path, enter the Larch grove and begin a steep climb. Turn left at the first crossroads to descend towards Les Antics.
- 3) Once you have passed the hamlet of Les Antics, continue along the road before turning right at the crossroads.
- 4) Continue along this road for 900m before turning left onto a narrow path that climbs steeply. Once back on the road, turn left to find the car park.
